POSITION: Adult Therapist

STATUS: Full Time

SUPERVISION: The Adult Therapist is directed by and reports to the Adult Clinical Supervisor.

FUNCTION: The Adult Therapist provides professional mental health, counseling and substance abuse counseling services in the White Mountain Apache Tribe under the Authority of Apache Behavioral Health Services. Provides general mental health counseling and substance abuse services to adult clients with various needs.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Ability to provide clinical services; assessment, individual, family and group therapy, for all required populations, in a variety of settings, including: in office, IHS hospital, Tribal; court, jail, client's homes and off reservation settings.
2. Ability to facilitate referral process to assure continuity of care with outside agencies and across programs at ABHS.
3. Ability to develop positive working relationships with IHS, Tribal; Court, Prosecution, Probation, Social Services, State; Court, Prosecution, Probation, DES/DDD and other programs as necessary.
4. Ability to provide twenty-four hour on-call rotation including irregular hours, weekend and holiday duty during on-call shift.
5. Ability to provide crisis services as needed in the office, court, jail, client's homes, hospital emergency room, etc.
6. Ability to maintain client records in accordance with ABHS, Federal, State, Tribal and local requirements.
7. Ability to maintain daily logs and service tickets with completed documentation in adherence with ABHS policy for billing purposes.
8. Provides adult mental health education for families, the public, and Tribal and/or community programs as applicable or directed.
9. Stays abreast of newest information concerning adult's mental health related topics and provides in-service education for ABHS Staff, Social Services and other agency staff as appropriate.
10. Participation in all required ABHS meetings and training, including weekly all staff and clinical staff meetings.
11. Attends all appropriate clinical management teams, including adult teams both within and outside of ABHS.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must possess an M.A./M.S./M.S.W. in a counseling/mental health field from a regionally accredited graduate program. Must be eligible for or possess Arizona licensure to practice as a mental health professional. Prefer one to two years experience working with Native Americans. Must possess a valid Arizona driver's license and have personal transportation, which may be used for business purposes with reimbursement for mileage as applicable. Must be able to work collaboratively in a rural multicultural setting. Indian preference for registered members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe or any registered member of a federally recognized Tribe or Nation, after meeting all other qualifications.
